Supermarkets

Foodsharing and sustainable initiatives

The initative foodsharing wants to avoid food waste. People who have bought too much, have a large orchard, or supermarkets that can no longer sell their baked goods give this food away for free. The Fairteiler serve as central points where food can be shared. There you can bring private food as well as food left over from pick-ups and take food yourself for free. Please handle it carefully and pay attention to hygiene.

- At TU: In the open room of the AStA, there is a fridge and a shelf for foodsharing. Room (S1/03 Room 63a)
- At h_da: you can find it in Schöfferstr. 8 in building D13, on the first floor, next to the Krabbelstube/across from the library.

Going out

Student bars and pubs:

- **Hobbit:** Cozy, rustic pub to sink into in immediate vicinity of the university. Very good pizza (also at lunchtime, if you don't feel like eating in the cafeteria).
- Hotzenplotz: Similar to Hobbit and also a leap away from college
- **Goldene Krone:** Cultural pub, whether drinking a cheap beer in the bar, playing table soccer, singing along with various live bands or dancing in the disco upstairs. In the Krone you can experience everything...
- Sausalitos: mexican bar+ restaurant
