



Declaration of consent for the use film recordings as well as personal information

I hereby agree that the Darmstadt Student Union may use the video recordings I have released as well as the data about me provided below for the following purpose:

- On the Student Union website from May 22nd, 2024 – September 30th, 2024
- As part of the “Diversity at Midday” campaign on May 29, 2024
- In the event of further campaigns at the Studentenwerk in the summer semester of 2024. (In this case, I will be informed about such a campaign at least two weeks before.)

This consent is given by me voluntarily and can be revoked at any time. All you need to do is send an informal message - in writing or by email datenschutz@stwda.de. If consent is revoked, the Student Union may not use any of my footage unless there is another legal basis.

Once I have given my consent, if my consent is revoked, the Studentenwerk is entitled to:

- that campaigns started with the images and personal information are completed (but not extended) and
- For online media, a period of 3 months is appropriate for the image material and personal information to be deleted or made unrecognizable.

I am aware that when film material is distributed via online media, films can be digitally copied and that the student union cannot guarantee that my film material will be completely deleted from the internet. The data protection declaration is attached and was also given to me.

Purpose of data collection

Your film recordings and your personal information will be used as part of the "Diversity at Lunch" campaign run by the Darmstadt Student Union. This campaign was created by the Darmstadt Student Union.

Types of data we process

As part of this consent, we will initially process the following personal data:

- Name and Surname
- E-mail address
- Film records

Categories of recipients

The film recordings will be published on the Darmstadt Student Union website as well as on social media such as Instagram and YouTube (private channel). The creator is free to mention his name as director and other actors in the appendix or to use the word "anonymous" in the appendix. The names and email addresses of the participants will not be passed on to third parties.

Recipients of the film material are all people who:

- Have access to the Darmstadt Student Union website,
- or on social media

Legal basis for processing

When processing your personal data, we naturally comply with applicable law. Processing therefore only takes place on a legal basis. The following legal basis comes into consideration:

- By granting consent to the processing of your personal data, we refer to Art. 9 II lit. a GDPR.

Transfer of data

The Darmstadt Student Union does not pass on any data to third parties.

Duration of storage

The personal data will be stored until September 30, 2024,

- To contact the winners at the awards ceremony
- To inform about a further campaign

Unless the data subject revokes their consent, objects to the processing or requests the deletion of their personal data; In this case, the data will only be stored for as long as is described in the declaration of consent or as legally required or permitted, for example to prove the legality of publications that have already been made.

It is explicitly pointed out that when published on the Internet - especially on social media - this data may no longer be completely removed and that third parties may have made copies.

Rights of the persons affected

- To request confirmation from us as to whether we are processing personal data relating to you; If this is the case, you have the right to information about this personal data and to the information listed in detail in Art. 15 GDPR.
- to request the release of the data concerning you in a common electronic, machine-readable data format in accordance with the restrictions of Art. 20 GDPR. This also includes the release (if possible) to another responsible person named directly by you.
- to request that we correct your data if it is incorrect, inaccurate and/or incomplete. Correction also includes completion through explanations or notification.
- to demand from us that personal data concerning you be deleted immediately:
- if one of the reasons listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies.
- Unfortunately, we are not allowed/cannot delete data that is subject to a statutory retention period or reasons stated in the consent.
- to revoke your consent with effect for the future without incurring any disadvantages to you.
- to demand that we restrict processing if one of the conditions listed in Article 18 GDPR is met.
- to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you for reasons relating to your particular situation.
- without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy and, if you believe that the processing of personal data concerning you violates the GDPR, to complain to:
 - our data protection officer (see person responsible) or
 - to a supervisory authority in the Member State of your place of residence, your place of work or the place of the alleged infringement.
